The Rev. Dr. John L. Heins Student Aid Endowment Fund

This fund was established with gifts from Guardian Lutheran Church, Dearborn, MI, Faith Lutheran Church, Grand Blanc, MI, and St. Paul Lutheran Church, Ann Arbor, MI, to honor the ministry and district presidency of Dr. John Heins among these three churches and in the Michigan District of the LCMS. Concordia Seminary President John F. Johnson presented the endowment on behalf of the Seminary and three congregations on June 23, 1997 during the District's convention at Concordia College, Ann Arbor.

Scholarships awarded from this endowment are prioritized for Michigan District-LCMS students needing financial assistance. More than 15 seminarians have received this scholarship since its inception.

Our Redeemer Lutheran-Dearborn Scholarship Endowment Fund

This fund was established by the members of Our Redeemer Lutheran Church, Dearborn, MI as the congregation made a difficult decision to close its doors. Rev. Rod Schultz presented the check to establish the endowment in August 2019.

Scholarships awarded from this endowment are prioritized for students in the Ethnic Immigrant Institute of Theology, then students from the Michigan District-LCMS. The Ethnic Immigrant Institute of Theology (EIIT) offers a specialized program of preparation for men who want to serve as pastors and women who want to serve as deaconesses in immigrant and ethnic minority communities in North America.
